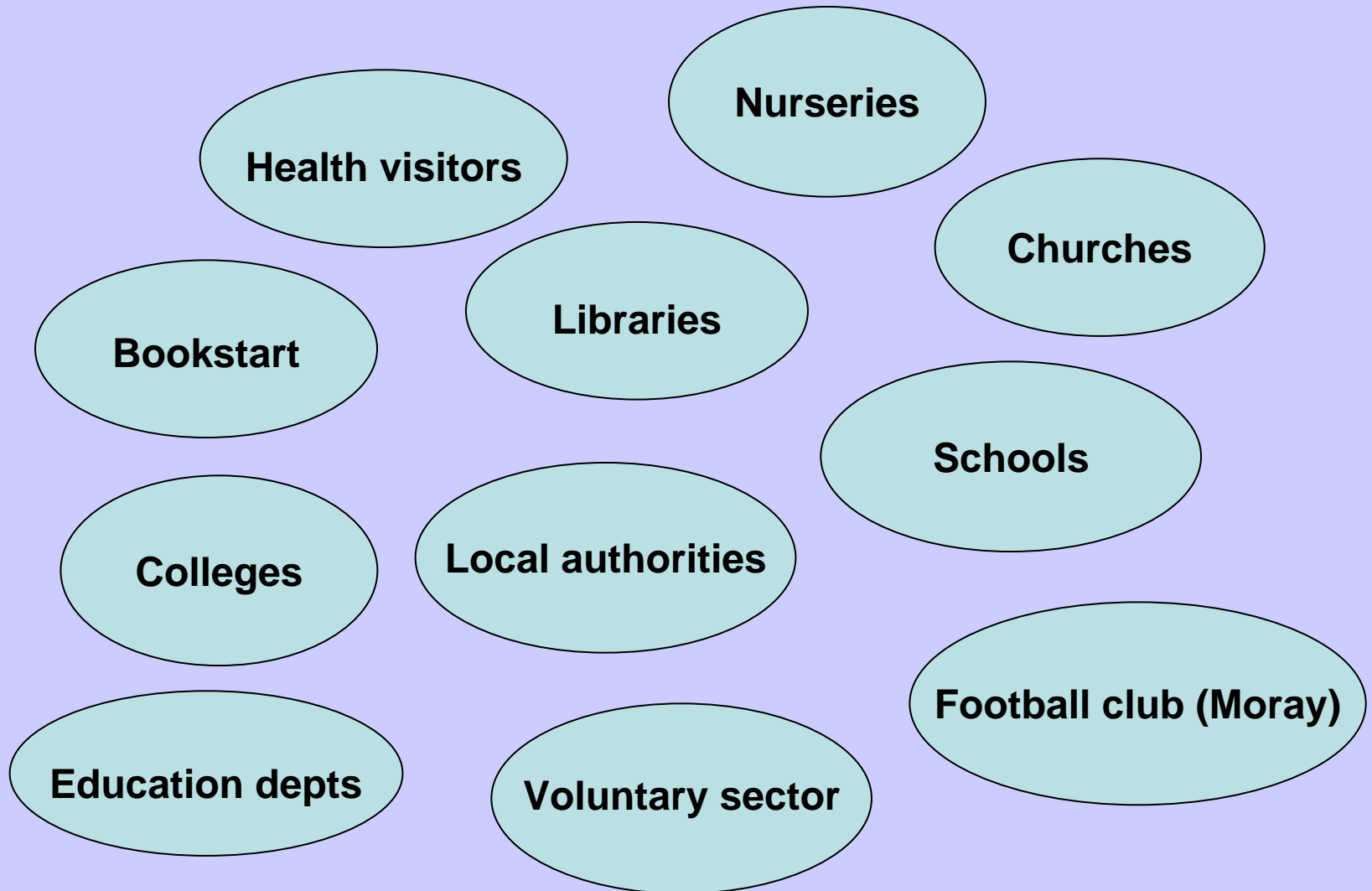
# Family/intergenerational ESOL
